Dedication ceremony for the New Diocesan Centre (Arachnortaran)

On the 15th March 2022, the Primate, His grace Bishop Hovakim Manukyan, invited members of the community and benefactors to the recently purchased Armenian Diocesan Centre in Brentford, west London, for a small dedication ceremony, before commencing the renovation of the premises.

Those present were the Armenian Ambassador, His Excellency Varuzhan Nersessyan, and prominent members of the Christian community, including His Eminence Archbishop Mor Athanasius Toma of the Syriac Orthodox Church, His Grace Bishop Mar Awraham Youkhanis of the Assyrian Church of the East, the Very Reverend Dr Chorepiscopus Patrick Sookhdeo, the International Director of the Barnabas Fund, Mr Armand Abramian, chair of the Armenian Community Council of Great Britain. The Primate led a guided tour of the new premises and shared his vision of the venue being the cultural and religious centre for Armenians in the UK. He concluded by thanking all those who have shown their continuous support for the project, both financially and with their hard work.

The dedication ceremony was concluded with speeches from all the representatives.
