

Armen Bablanian 1952-2024

It is with great sadness that we announce that Armen Bablanian, a long-time parishioner of St. Yeghiche Armenian Church, passed away on 17th November 2024, after a prolonged illness.

Armen served as an elected member of St Yeghiche Armenian Church Parish Council until his health deteriorated.

Born in Kirkuk, Iraq, in 1952, Armen moved to London in the early 1980's where he took on a position at Peabody Trust, working for over 25 years before he retired.
